

### Applications for the Master 2 NFC (2020-2021) have to be submitted online at:

https://ecandidat.univ-lyon1.fr/

**DEADLINE: 17 June 2020** 

**NB**: For the academic year 2020-2021, the application procedure is **entirely on-line**. **No paper application** has to be sent.

Fill-in the questionnaire and take note of the username and password that will be assigned to you (for the follow-up of your application), then

A. add the required documents (see below) : any incomplete or incorrectly completed application will be refused

B. validate on-line the completed application ("Transmettre ma candidature")

## **Prerequisites**

- Validation of 4 years of higher education
- Validation of at least 6 credits in Neuroscience or related disciplines
- Validation of at least 9 credits in English

### **Documents to include**

#### For all the students:

- Cover letter,
- Curriculum vitae,
- Certificate of enrollment in the Master 1 of the current year (or any other current enrollment),
- Photocopies of all diplomas, starting from the Baccalaureate or the secondary school diploma, and corresponding certificates including: rank, number of students in the promotion and the notes of all the courses.
- List of all the Neuroscience courses, including the marks obtained,
- Photocopy of the certificate of completion of the Master 1 (semesters 1 & 2; including notes, rank and number of students). If you are unable to provide this document, send it as soon as possible by e-mail to marion.richard@univ-lyon1.fr; emiliano.macaluso@univ-lyon1.fr and scolarite.biosciences@univ-lyon1.fr
- List of English courses taken since the baccalaureate with marks obtained,
- A pre-acceptance letter from a research host laboratory (4th semester internship), including a brief description of the internship project (5 lines).

## **M2 NFC - Admission**



NB: Any additional doc supporting your application should be submitted with your Cover letter, as a single merged pdf file (ex. for medical students your application or letter of acceptance for an "année recherche" by ARS, description of previous training for students from engineering schools, etc...)

#### For foreign students:

In addition to the documents listed above,

- The official program of the studies followed abroad,
- Results of French level test: TCF level 4 or equivalent DELF B2, to justify that French is fluently spoken, read and written

All documents must be translated into French and certified in accordance with the original.

#### Additional notes:

- You will need to bring and present your original diplomas/documents to the University at the time of enrollment in September
- For French and European Union students outside Lyon 1, include a list of all the courses and their educational content.
- Students from outside the European Union are allowed to apply for a position in the Master maximum two times.
- Any falsified document or false declaration will result in a ban on enrolling in French public higher education institutions.

#### Time-line of the application process

02 May 2020: Opening of the "eCandidat" platform

17 June 2020 : Deadline for the submission of the applications

25-26 June 2020: Meeting of the commission that will select the candidates

16 July 2020: Deadline for students to accept a position in the program using the "eCandidat" platform

- Candidates will be informed of the commission's decision exclusively via the "eCandidat" platform. No information will be given over the phone;
- Any successful candidate who does not formally accept their position in the program by the 16/07/2019 (using the "eCandidat" platform) will be considered as declining the offer;
- After confirming your acceptance, it is advisable to regularly visit the Master's website where you will find important information concerning administrative enrollment procedures, the Master kick-off meeting (early September), and the first courses.
- Unsuccessful applicants can only re-apply to the Master in the following years if they have acquired a new diploma.
